DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

This includes monitoring wildlife, both individuals and populations, birds, invertebrates, and reptiles; as well as ecological variables and influencers such as fire occurrence, invasive species, flood levels and rainfall. Other activities will include camera trap surveys, tree impact assessments, aerial surveys, and fixed-point photography.

- Conservation or environmental related studies with a minimum of 2 years' field experience.
